

This look book presents the work of members of the World Fair Trade Organization (WFTO).

The WFTO Fair Trade verification system tells us more than just how a garment is made. It sustains mission-led enterprises in their crucial work to create dignified employment and care for the environment. In this project, which marks the 16th edition of showcasing globally the unique characteristics of Fair Trade production, we invite the European fashion market to experience the storytelling and craftsmanship of these Fair Trade brands. The participants are placed into creative dialogue with each other, and we imagine the resulting cross-cultural assortment of garments and accessories as a unified collection.

This expo reflects the design vision of the WFTO-verified brands, which goes beyond just craft. Experience this immersive exhibition that will take you to the creators, the techniques and the solutions they are addressing. These pioneering brands are powerfully reimagining fashion in a global context, by fusing artisanal techniques and the avantgarde, while never compromising the integrity of production.

These verified Fair Trade brands' contributions are paired with the work of six students from the Sustainable Fashion program at BSP, Berlin, using WFTO members' textiles.
